

# COVID-19 UPDATE:

Updated February 16, 2022

Recently the Taiso Board met to discuss upcoming changes to the provincial COVID 19 regulations. A decision has been made to follow the guidelines provided by the Government of Saskatchewan and our governing body, Gymnastics Saskatchewan.

Until February 28th, masks will be mandatory inside Taiso Gymnastics. No spectators will be allowed in the building, with the exception of one spectator per Kinder 3 and 4 participant.

The following changes come into effect February 28 12:01 am.

1. **Masks will no longer be mandatory.** Taiso will continue to be a mask friendly environment. Staff, coaches, athletes and spectators are strongly encouraged to continue wearing masks in the building.
1. **Spectators will be allowed in the gym.** To maintain the health of our staff and athletes we would like to limit the number of people in the gym as much as possible. We would appreciate you dropping your athletes off and remaining outside of the building whenever possible.

All other precautions will remain in place. This includes increased cleaning measures, hand washing/sanitizing and not entering the building while experiencing any cold or flu like symptoms. Athletes exhibiting symptoms will be asked to leave. To help reduce the risk of transmission, the use of rapid tests is recommended.

We recognize this may be a stressful time for everyone. Please treat everyone with kindness and respect as we adapt to these changes. If you have questions or concerns, please contact your athlete's coach or a Taiso staff member. They have the full support of the board members and will reach out to us if necessary.
